NEWS FROM SAMS:

2TH ANNUAL LONG COURSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Congratulations to the Tshwane Region on hosting an amazing 26th Long Course Championships. The event was held at the Hillcrest Swimming Pool in Pretoria, Gauteng from the 17th to the 20th of March 2010

Thanks to John Peterson for compiling all the statistics.

A FEW INTERESTING STATS FROM THE EVENT:

- 450 Swimmers from 21 Club entered Nationals; 220 Women and 230 Men
- 18 Foreign Swimmers from Russia, UK, Swaziland and Germany.
- 417 Swimmers eventually competed.
- 388 Swimmers scored points for their club in individual races.
- 291 Relay teams were entered.
- 7 of the swimmers entered were 80 years and older.
- The oldest female competitor was Rae Smit (90).
- The oldest male competitor was Paul Mulder (86).

RECORDS

- 37 South African Records were broken by 19 swimmers in the individual events.
- 6 South African Records were broken by 1 club in the relay events.
- 1 South African Record was broken in the Dash-for-Cash events.
- In addition 2 second place finishers (1 individual and 1 relay) also bettered the old South African Record.

COLOURS

- South African Masters Swimming Colours qualifying times were bettered 51 times by 19 different South African Swimmers during the championships.
- 22 Swimmers (14 women & 8 men) who qualified throughout the 2009/2010 season were awarded their Colours.

In addition there were 3 swimmers who qualified on time in the 2009/2010 season, but have yet to participate in 3 national long course championships.

OPEN WATER SWIMMING - SA MASTERS SWIMMING COLOURS

It has been decided to award SA Masters Swimming Colours for Open Water Swimming. Thanks to Derek Fyfe and those who ably assisted him, the qualifying times for 3km has been established for the respective Masters' age groups.

Ann Gray has been appointed to the SAMS Committee as the Open water representative for the rest of the year. A few issues and technicalities still have to be considered and discussed at the SAMS meeting with regional Presidents on 24th July in Durban.

In the mean time open water swimmers are encouraged to enter the Sun City 3km swim on 23rd October and the 3km swim at the Rynfield Mile on 30th October, both of which will be SSA sanctioned.

Once the dates are confirmed for more SSA recognised 3 km swims, they will be distributed to the regions for further distribution to the various Masters Swimming Clubs.

REGISTRATIONS:

The new registrations will commence on 1st May 2010. Remember to take advantage of the Early Bird Registration Date and win a cash prize which covers your registration fee for the season.

"Cut off date," means the last and final date for all necessary forms (i.e. forms 1-4) together with proof of payment to be on the desk top/computer of SAMS' registration appointee.
