Oudtshoorn

The 27th Annual South African Masters Swimming Championship, which took place from 16 - 19 March 2011 in Oudtshoorn, was a wonderful experience for all the Masters swimmers who attended this event. Records were broken, medals were won, personal bests achieved and much fun was

had by all. Oudtshoorn did what Oudtshoorn does best hot weather- perfect for swimming, friendly people and ancient landscapes - all under the beautiful Karoo sky. Even a thunder storm could not dampen the swimmers spirits. Happy hour was held at High Gate Ostrich Farm and the Big Bamboo was a huge Highlight! The Awards Dinner was so colourful and the 60's theme <u>rocked!</u>

HIGHLIGHTS

5 World records were broken - all by Cape Town Masters Swimmers. The first WR was broken by Cecilia Stanford who swam a brilliant 400m IM in the 50 - 54 age group (5.37.60). In the 45- 49 age group Edith Ottermann broke the 50m freestyle WR (26.59) and Sanderina Kruger broke the WR in the 50m freestyle in the 60 - 64 age group (30.19). Cecilia Stanford also broke the WR in the 200m IM in the 50- 54 age group (2.36.62) and finally a further World Record was broken in the 4×50 m ladies 200 age group by Sanderina Kruger, Cecilia Stanford, Marcelle Strauss and Edith Ottermann (1.56.04).

Awarded to the SAMS Club scoring the most points per entered swimmer at the SAMS Long Course Championships. Individual and relay points count. For this award there is a prescribed minimum of 8 entered swimmers per Club. Clubs with less than 8 entered swimmers have their total points divided by 8.

Edith Ottermann (Cape Town MSC) (3.10% under the World Record in the 50m Freestyle) Awarded to the Female Swimmer with the best time at the SAMS Long Course Championships, measured (%) against the world record.

*Best Performance - Male (Donated by Allen Morrison)

Andre Steynberg (Wahoo MSC) (2.19% over the World Record in the 50m Backstroke)

Awarded to the Male Swimmer with the best time at the SAMS Long Course Championships, measured (%) against the world record.

* Peter Pirow Cup (Donated by the Pirow family)

Cecilia Stanford (Cape Town MSC) (1.24% under the World Record)

Awarded to the Male or Female Swimmer with the best time in the 400m Individual Medley at the SAMS Long Course Championships, measured (%) against the world record.

Mike Arendse (Cape Town MSC) (35.48% improvement in the 400m Individual Medley)

Awarded to the SAMS Swimmer who shows the greatest % improvement in time for any one event at the SAMS Long Course Championships. Times are measured against the swimmer's recorded time for the same event at the SAMS Long Course Championships of the previous year.

* Colin Cable Award (Donated by Western Province Masters Swimming and Lynda Gower)

Dave McLachlan (Cape Town MSC) (Tricia Rix of Cape Town MSC scored the same number of points but is younger)

Awarded to the SAMS Male or Female Swimmer at the SAMS Long Course Championships, who is 60 years or over, swam 6 events, and scored the most points, with the events being scored on a scale of endurance. In the event of a tie, the oldest swimmer will receive the award.
